

Modeling of business processes with Enterprise Architect (EA) – a basic course

To understand and to document your business processes properly is a primary key for effective system design and even more – a must - for service oriented architecture. You will learn how to document and model your processes with notation grammar of UML. On the second day's afternoon participants are invited to discuss their actual practical tasks in a guided workshop.
